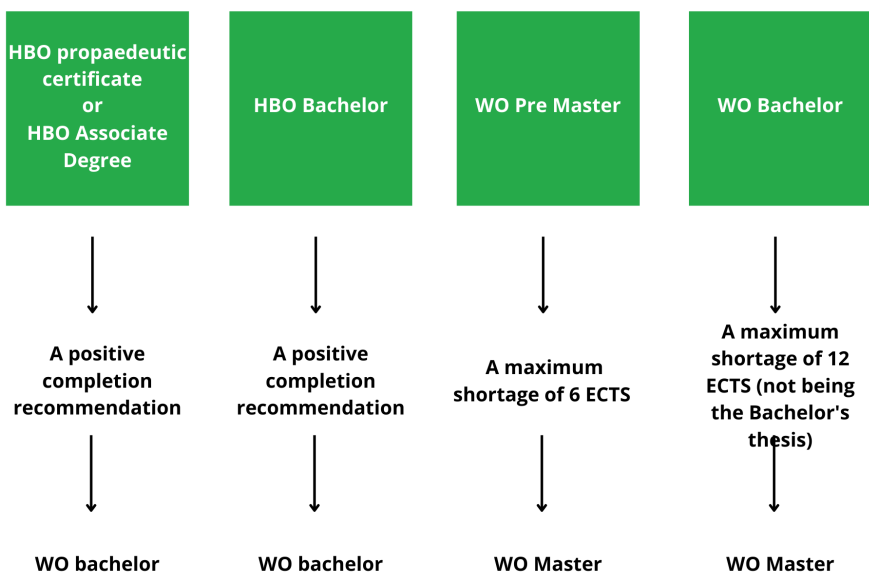
... that it is now possible to play jeu de boules on campus. You can collect a playing set at the security office in building Vigilant.

... that the windows in the passageway between C and K were first empty but because too many birds flew against them, quotes were put on them.

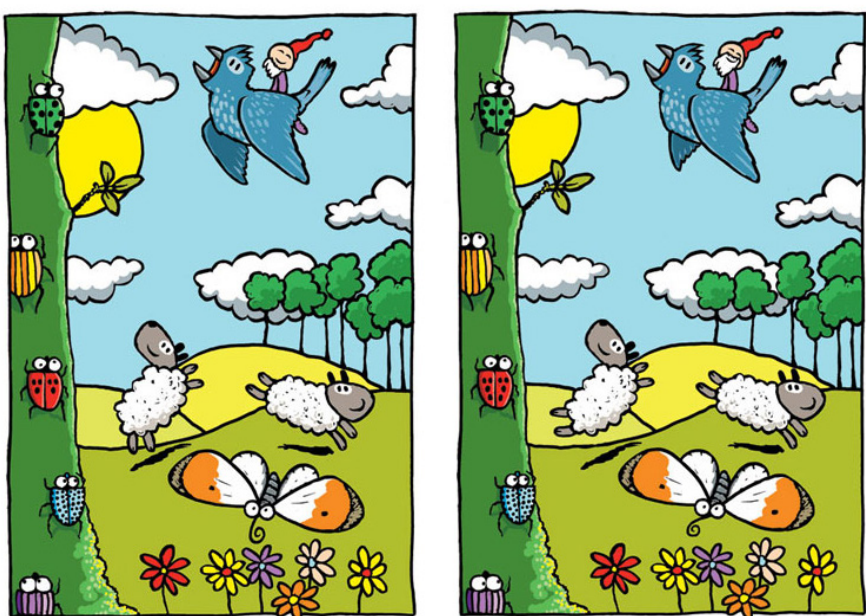
Soft Cut

New Building

As you have probably noticed, the parking lot between CUBE and Tias has disappeared. This area will be used for a new education building. The new building is needed because the number of students is growing and the way of teaching is changing. The building contains one large lecture hall (400 students) and a great number of smaller lecture rooms of various sizes. Also a lot of (self) study areas and a foyer with a small kiosk for snacks. When all lecture halls and study areas are occupied, the building will accommodate approximately 1,000 students. It is designed as a highly sustainable building, with much attention to circularity. For example, the building will have a wooden supporting structure that is almost entirely re-usable, which is unique for an educational building. Partly due to the use of solar panels and underground heat storage, the building will be nearly carbon neutral. In addition, the surrounding terrain will also be redesigned, with a focus on a park like image. You will get a better walking connection for pedestrians to the NS station as well. The building is expected to be completed in 2024.



Annual Report 2021

Last University Council, the Annual Report of 2021 has been discussed. In the annual report, the Executive Board looks back on the past year in the context of a number of topics, including education, research, quality agreements, the campus and community, sustainability and partnerships. The mission of Tilburg University is as follows: We strive to advance society by deepening our understanding of that society. We educate our students with the goal of developing the knowledge, skills and character they need to meet today's challenges. Connected as we are to society, we dedicate excellent research to "a good life" for all. This year the University also formed a new strategy for the next five years. This strategy is in line with the ambitions in the annual report. Some facts from the annual report:

- There are 4.231 international students and a total of 112 nationalities at the University
- 5.971 diplomas have been awarded in 2021
- The turnover of the University was 268 million euros
- There are 22 bachelor's-, 52 master's- and 34 English programs
