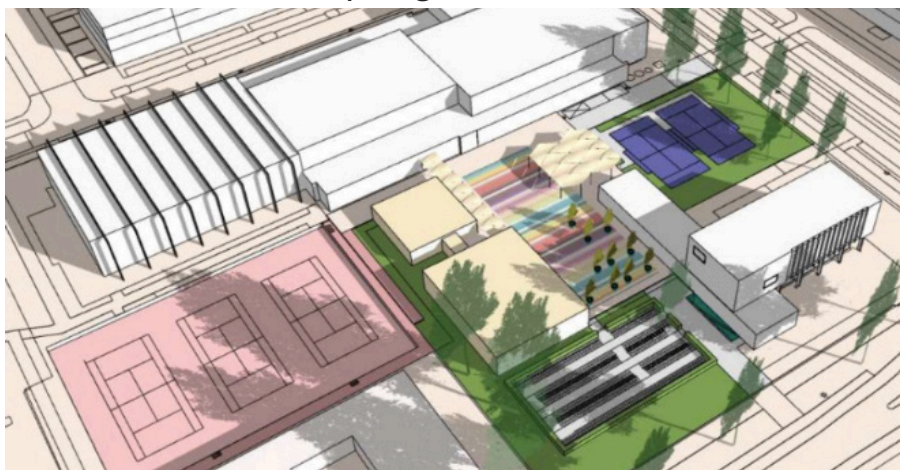

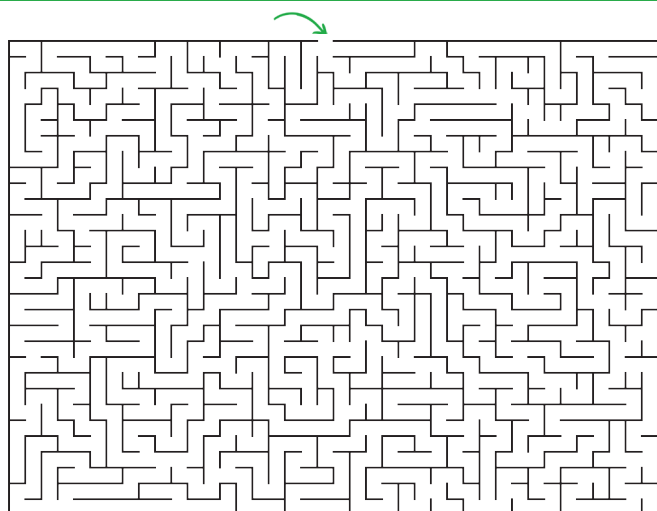
## Budget Request Expansion Olympia

Due to the demolition of a section of a former TiU building, there is now an opportunity to expand the sports facilities at Olympia. The Executive Board has requested funds for a temporary expansion. This expansion will address some of the acute bottlenecks of the sports center: Fitness capacity will increase by 23% and the capacity for group training by 13% and there will be a CrossFit area. If there is enough room, possibly a padel court will be added to the program. There will also be



facilities aimed at better accommodating exam students, including bicycle racks. The proposed expansion could cause a small increase in the price of the sports membership. The addition is temporary as the university is working on a larger project regarding renewal of the entire sports facilities within in a few years. We will discuss these plans in the UC in summer.

## Elections

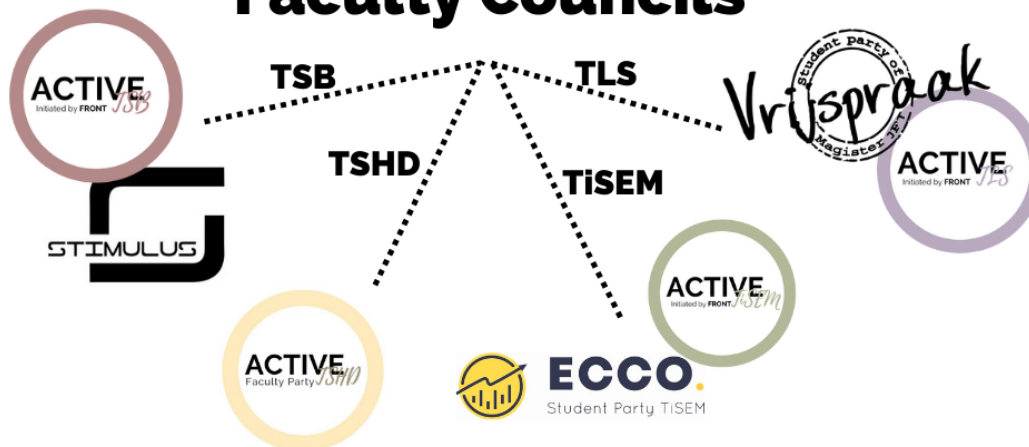

## Emergency Fund Ukraine

The war in Ukraine has a major impact on Tilburg University students from the countries involved. Students who are directly affected could face acute financial problems. It is possible to donate to Tilburg University's emergency fund to help the affected students of Tilburg University. You can do this by scanning the qr code.

In addition, a few weeks ago, five Ukrainian students started a collection point for humanitarian goods for ukraine. It was a success and with the help of 150 volunteers, they managed to send three trucks with goods to Ukraine.

There will also be events at the University related to the war. On the 11th of April, the Secretary of Defense will give a lecture at the University on the state and future of defense. He will be accompanied by Colonel Peter Tankink who will discuss the latest developments in Ukraine and what that means for Defense.
