



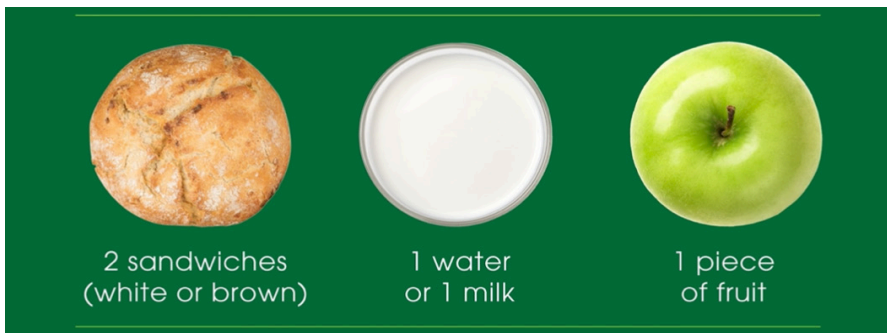
## Did you know...

## Update University Council + Front's Initiative

February 9th was the third University Council meeting of the academic year. Various topics were discussed, including elaboration notes on student housing and the digitalisation of the university, namely TUNED IN. We advised positively on the memo about student housing, but emphasized that it is extremely important to look at long-term solutions. We also believe that it is important for the university to include the interests of the student in discussions with the municipality. In the memo about digitalisation we asked questions about the time plan. In addition, we think it is important that enough money is invested in this, so that the digitalisation is properly developed. Moreover, we have once again emphasized that we think it is important that an interim solution is found for these developments, by recording lectures, as stated in our letter from the previous University Council. A memo concerning social safety was also discussed. We asked several questions about the goals, the accountability and the culture change that is needed to achieve this.

Last but not least, Front handed in an initiative proposal on the Edubadges for board members, which will give them formal recognition and appreciation for their board year by handing out digital badges. For more information, check the initiative on our website!
